> Training Course Program

- Jordi Torrent, Chair of the Cooperation Committee, presented the new of the MEDPorts training program for 2021-2022. This Training program was tailored thanks to a survey of the Committee in the Med Ports inquiring for the most researched profiles.
- Jordi Torrent stated that ETME committee strongly invited training institutions to develop a comprehensive training offer in order to cover the requested future job profiles in Mediterranean Port Authorities.
- The courses developed by Five port training Institutes as members of the MEDports Association with allocated budged 8,000€ (Per course) with support of MEDPorts Association, are as follows:
 - L'Institut Marseille Cybersecurity
 - Arab Academy Supply Chain Resilience
 - Fundación ValenciaPort Digital Transition
 - Escola Barcelona Energy Transition
 - IMFMM Maritime Transport and Supply Chain
