The Forum is organized together by MEDports Association and Port System Authority of Central Northern Tyrrhenian Sea – Port of Civitavecchia.

The MEDports Forum 2022 will be a place of gathering and exchange of opinions, ideas and best practices among the representatives of the international institutions, experts of maritime transport and port activities, and leading port members in order to assist Mediterranean ports in building a resilient, progressive, and vibrant maritime sector through the use of digitalisation.

Through concrete testimonies, reflections of experts and positioning of international organisations and institutions, the MEDports Forum 2022 is an incredible opportunity for all the actors of the world maritime transport to update their knowledge, to exchange their best practices and to project themselves in the world of tomorrow.
